

Warrant of Arrest to the custodian or by leaving a copy with the person in charge at the place at which the Vessel is arrested; and it is further

ORDERED, that if the Vessel is not released within 14 days after execution of process, Plaintiff shall promptly publish notice of the action in The Daily Record or other newspaper having general circulation in the district, pursuant to Admiralty Rule C(4) and Local Admiralty Rule C(3)(a)(i); and it is further

ORDERED, that any person claiming an interest in the property arrested pursuant thereto may, upon a showing of any improper practice or a manifest want of equity on the part of Plaintiff, be entitled to an order requiring Plaintiff to show cause forthwith why the arrest should not be vacated or any other relief granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiff shall give or attempt notice of this action to every person known to have an ownership interest in the Vessel pursuant to Local Admiralty Rule C (3); and it is further

ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be attached to and served with said Warrant of Arrest.
